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



Interface PageOS has an easy to navigate interface that allows users to build customizable workspaces referred to as Pages. • Use the thumbstick to move left and right between custom pages Press the thumbstick to make a selection • Press the back button to return to the previous screen • Press and hold the custom function buttons to reassign functionality • Move the thumbstick UP to engage pixel zoom. Press the thumbstick IN to move around the image. Press the back button to return to normal view. **Adding New Pages** To create a new page from either a fresh workspace, a template, or a specific utility, navigate to the right-hand side of the Pages View. Add New Tool to a Page Tap your screen while on any page to reveal the toolbar. Press the plus sign that appears on the left side of the page. Select the tool you want added to that page. **Activating Tools** Tap your screen while on any page to reveal the toolbar. Then select the tool you want to activate. To adjust the custom settings of that tool press the arrow that appears next to the name of the tool.
